Launched by a group of universities in Central and South Eastern Europe, this initiative provides **hands-on support to researchers in the field of biomedicine** and related fields who want to:

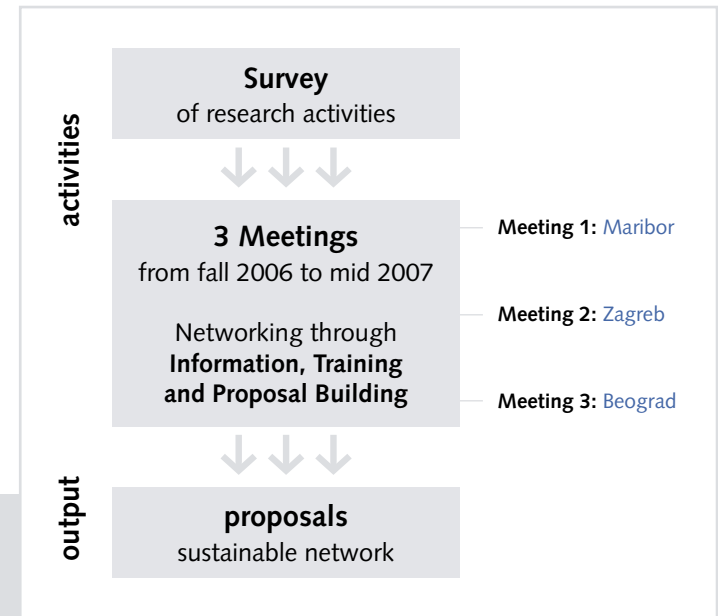
- ▶▶ Cooperate with colleagues from the region and further abroad
